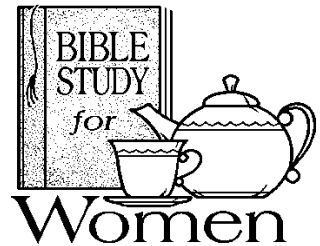
VBS Planning

The Fifth Commandment

The first four commandments teach us how to love and honor God. The last six concern themselves with our relationships to other people. The Fifth Commandment links the two groups.

God's Fifth Commandment establishes the family as the foundation of human society; it is the heart and core of our nation. God herein delegates His authority for a child's

upbringing to the parents, and places upon them the responsibility for teaching children to love, respect and obey their parents, authority and God Himself.

Respect for authority applies to everyone in every relationship. Such honor and respect requires the child to learn the discipline necessary

to conduct his/her life with the spirituality given by God, and in obedience to His commands.

As the prelude to the final five commandments, the fifth establishes love and respect for those created by God. To dishonor others — especially one's parents — is to dishonor God. The child who is not taught respect at home will not demonstrate respect elsewhere. Just as one must love God in order to love one's parents, one must love the parents in order to love others.

It is well to note that this commandment has its origins in the first: "You shall have no other gods before me," and its concept continues in the next three. It is love and respect for God and all that represents Him — His personhood, His image, His name and the day He set aside for us to worship Him — that generates love and respect for our parents and those created by God. †

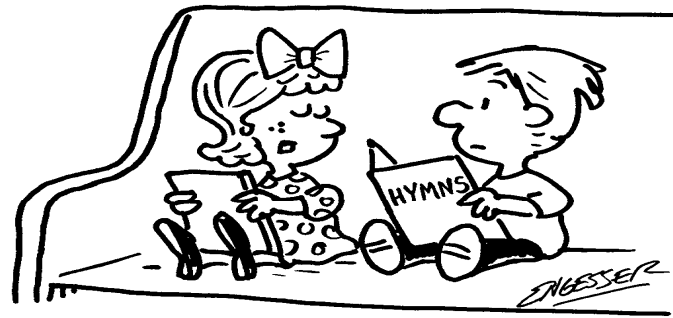
